Sub-Saharan Africa - Adolescents and Young People Dashboard



The Africa Adolescents and Youth Dashboard is an automated visualization and map of sexual and reproductive health data on adolescents and youth.

The AY Dashboard provides up-to-date information on reproductive health among youth for all of sub-Saharan Africa. With data sourced largely from three major household surveys (the Demographic and Health Survey [DHS], the Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey [MICS], and the AIDS Indicator Survey [AIS]), the tool shows current status, progress, and trends for critical indicators. The web map service aims to be a single, comprehensive repository and presentation of data on adolescents and young people essential for evidence-based programming.

## Features

- User-friendly design for easy data analysis
- Country-level comparison available on map and in rank chart
- Overlay feature shows correlation of multiple indicators on map
- Up-front indicator disaggregation for easy selection
- Multi-sectoral information for the selected areas

- Data definitions and analytical statements are available for easy understanding of indicators
