



Stakeholders lack a mechanism and platform for planning and monitoring comprehensive actions toward National Priorities




Planning and Monitoring Silos create barriers and inefficiencies – gov't-to-gov't and with development partners

Large data sets have not translated into evidence-based decision-making




Limited mechanisms to engage civil society and private sector in plans to achieve National Development Priorities


Capacity gaps limit use of data in planning and decision-making




PROGRESS AGAINST NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN STRATEGIC PRIORITIES




PROGRESS AGAINST NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN STRATEGIC PRIORITIES - KPI-




GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE ACROSS THE NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN







STATUS OF ACTIVITIES CONTRIBUTING TO THE NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN



Strengthening Results-Based Monitoring






Development plans with results matrix are developed collaboratively and transparently through an online platform.

Structured planning ensures inclusion of baseline data and targets as well as measurable indicators.

Sector plans are linked to national development plans, referencing common targets and indicators.

Targets and indicators are tagged by sector, responsibility, geography, SDG.

Financial measures are included to ensure plans have resources to be achieved.



National Development Plans and Sector plans are linked to a clear source of data.

Indicator data are drawn from sources according to reporting frequency.

Data are entered once and reflected across all plans. Data validation processes ensure high quality results.

Responsible stakeholders are accountable for regular monitoring of progress against development plans.

Collaborative monitoring reduces burden and increases accountability for multi-stakeholder plans.

Regular reporting provides transparency on progress against development priorities.


Applied international standards (IATI) facilitate reporting of financial resources and expenditure.

Activity level tracking allows for coordinated collaboration between all development partners: gov't, civil society, private sector, and development partners.

Custom dashboards allow tailored reporting on development progress.
