The UN Women data portal helps the organization increase transparency by disseminating project data publicly.

The International Aid Transparency Initiative (IATI) commits signatories to disclose information on aid spending to allow stakeholders to find, use, and compare this data. UN Women, in its goal to act as a global leader for institutional transparency, used the opportunity to develop a portal with advanced dissemination tools. The web-based platform can be used for information tracking, monitoring and evaluation; it allows customized data searches, and user-friendly data downloads.

- Global project data available in IATI-compliant structure
- Information represented on various visualizations – tables, map
- Global representation of the fund's presence
- Download option available for the IATI-compliant project data

- Increased focus on disseminating data in a transparent way
- IATI compliant data can be used by other 3rd party tools also
