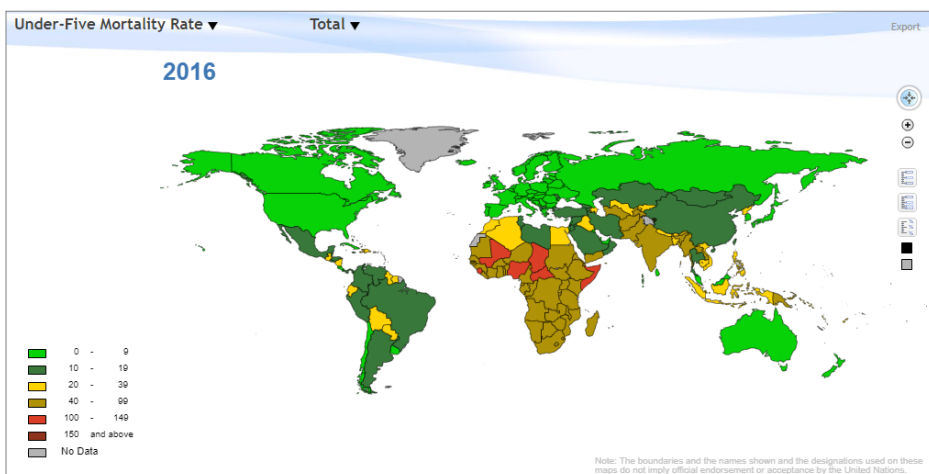

Child Mortality Estimates; Manage Data Portal

Project CME Info is a web portal containing all available data and the latest child mortality estimates for each country based on the research of the UN Inter-agency Group for Child Mortality Estimation.

The UN Inter-agency Group for Child Mortality Estimation (UN IGME) was formed in 2004 to share data on child mortality, harmonize estimates within the UN system, improve methods for child mortality estimation, report on progress towards child survival goals and enhance country capacity to produce timely and properly assessed estimates of child mortality. UN IGME, led by the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and the World Health Organization (WHO), also includes the World Bank Group and the United Nations Population Division of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs as full members.

CSF has been contracted to import the huge series data for Under-five Mortality Rate, Infant Mortality Rate and Neonatal Mortality Rate to the CME Info web portal database through XLS files. CSF has also created estimate for each country using the country series data and B3 model for all above Indicators.
